MUSIC MINISTRY

Few songs remain in common use after 1,500 years. "Be Thou My Vision" is among these enduring compositions. The lyrics are attributed to Saint Dallán Forgaill, a 6th-century Irish monk and poet. Dallán, whose name translates as "little blind one," is said to have lost his eyesight due to rigorous study of Scripture. The poem served as a personal prayer and an invocation to perceive life through God's eyes, making Him the sole focus and treasure of the heart. The melody most frequently associated with "Be Thou My Vision" (referred to as SLANE) is a traditional Irish folk tune. It derives its name from the Hill of Slane, where Saint Patrick is believed to have lit a Paschal fire in defiance of the local pagan high king.

EXPLORING THE CATHOLIC FAITH

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. John Eudes was a prominent 17th-century French missionary and spiritual leader who dedicated his life to the renewal of the Church through priestly formation and the promotion of devotion to the Sacred Hearts of Jesus and Mary . After being ordained a priest, he became



a tireless preacher, conducting numerous missions across France. Recognizing the critical need for better-formed clergy, he founded the Congregation of Jesus and Mary (the Eudists) in 1643, specifically for the education of priests in seminaries, a work he considered vital for the Church's spiritual health. St. John Eudes was also instrumental in establishing the liturgical worship of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and the Holy Heart of Mary, composing their Masses and Offices, and is recognized as the "Author of the Liturgical Worship of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Holy Heart of Mary". Additionally, he founded the Congregation of Our Lady of Charity of the Refuge in 1641 to assist women seeking spiritual refuge. Canonized in 1925, St. John Eudes remains a significant figure for his contributions to priestly formation and his pioneering role in popularizing devotion to the Sacred Hearts.
